Gospel Lesson from John 20:19-31
Pastor Deatrich provided this outline for you:

## Part 1--John 20-19-23;

Where: Upper room

When: Same Day when Mary discovered the Empty tomb. First day after Sabbath. Why: To verify to all the disciples, not just the inner circle we later called apostles,

what Mary had said to them about seeing Jesus.

To empower the Disciples with the Holy Spirit; this is not the same as the Pentecost event.

It is about relationships with God.

## Part 2--John 20-24-31

Where: Upper Room,

When; Same as part 1 and eight days later.

Why: To satisfy Thomas' desire to see the physical Jesus.

Jesus wanted to calm Thomas' anxiety concerning the Resurrection.
